By joining the Chula Vista Rangers Soccer Club, I am certain each of you realize the serious nature of the commitment and that this endeavor should not be entered into lightly or with reluctance. The Chula Vista Rangers Soccer Club understands that our players cannot achieve a high level of performance or success without a solid foundation. The club is committed to the philosophy the development of the "complete player" is our primary goal. Our coaches will be focusing on individual skills that will be incorporated into a team oriented game. Each player will continue to learn and take that knowledge to the next level, the fundamentals of soccer: passing, dribbling, trapping, and finishing. 2. Player payment – Your player registration payment must be paid in full prior to the club issuing your child their uniform and the 2010 CYSA Player ID card, which is required for playing in tournaments and in the Presidio Soccer League.
 3. Uniform sizes – All available size jerseys and short samples will be available for “sizing” to the individual teams once practice begins. It essential your child try on the jerseys and shorts for order sizes. If you provide the club a wrong size you will have to purchase an additional uniform at your own cost.
 4. Player warm-ups and backpacks – These items are “optional” and are not part of the registration fees. All available size warm up jackets and warm up pants samples will be available for “sizing” to the individual teams once practice begins.
 5. Club gear – Optional club gear (i.e. – baseball caps, polo shirts, sweatshirts, etc.) will be available to club members. Further ordering information will be provided once teams start practicing.
 6. Volunteers needed – We need your help for our club to continue growing and providing a “high quality” soccer environment for its players.

A board member will be available at registration to provide more information and hopefully “sign you up” to help!

7. Start of practice / Team meeting – Your team head coach or team manager will contact you directly to inform you when practice will start.

Player, Parent, and Family Agreement

The player, parent and family agree:

1. The player shall maintain a level of performance at school and at home which is sufficient to allow a commitment to participate in all team activities.
2. The player shall make every reasonable effort to attend practice sessions, games and tournaments.
3. The player shall call the team coach if unable to be in attendance.
4. The player shall be punctual (on time) with gear on and a ball for all practices and games.
5. The player shall always give the coach and staff their utmost respect, whether they agree with them or not.
6. The player shall treat the team program as a serious learning experience.
7. The player shall abide by the coach's instructions during training and game day preparations.
8. The player shall make every effort to win each game in a manner befitting the tradition of the CV Rangers SC.
9. The player shall respect game officials and the opponents both in defeat, as well as in victory.
10. The player agrees that unsportsmanship conduct can be grounds for suspension or dismissal.
11. The player shall shake hands after each game, be gracious in victory, as well as in defeat.
12. Parents shall provide encouragement and create a good learning environment.

13. Parents and players shall refrain from inappropriate or negative behavior, through actions or words towards referees, coaches, officers of the club, or other parents from their teams or opponents.
14. Parents shall not coach players, as they have to be able to think at crucial moments in the game.
15. Parents shall make every effort to pay their fees on time. If you are unsure as to your balance, it is your responsibility to find out what they are.
16. Players and parents agree to be an alcohol-free, drug-free soccer & smoking free team.
17. Players and parents shall not use profane language on the soccer field.
18. It takes a great deal of work on everyone's part, to make a soccer season a success. If everyone pitches in and does a little, a great deal will get done. The family will make every reasonable effort to participate in the tasks of running a team, some of which are, chaperoning, transporting players, making phone calls and fund raising as necessary.

Failure to comply with the aforementioned guidelines and policies can be grounds for player or parent suspension from games and/or termination from the Chula Vista Rangers Soccer Club.

Professional Conduct Policy and Prohibition against Harassment

The Chula Vista Rangers Soccer Club (the "club") is proud of its professional and congenial work and player environment, and will take the necessary steps to ensure this environment remains pleasant for all who represent the club in an official or unofficial capacity. This includes, but is not limited to independent contractors, contracted coaches, players, volunteers, parents or the officers of the club. All parties associated with or representing the Chula Vista Rangers Soccer Club must treat each other with courtesy, consideration and professionalism. The Chula Vista Ranger Soccer Club will not tolerate unlawful harassment of any person associated with the club by any representative of the club or his/her proxies for any reason. Harassment for any discriminatory reason, such as race, sex, national origin, disability, sexual orientation, age, or religion, is prohibited by state and federal laws, which may subject the Chula Vista Rangers Soccer Club and/or the individual harasser to liability for any such unlawful conduct. Accordingly, any derogatory, racial, ethnic, religious, age, sexual orientation, sexual or other inappropriate remarks, slurs, or jokes will not be tolerated. This policy applies not only to relationships between contractors and volunteers of the club, but also to relationships with our players, parents, suppliers and clients.

Sexual harassment includes unwelcome sexual advances, request for sexual favors, or any other visual, verbal, or physical conduct of a sexual nature when:

1. Submission to the conduct is made either implicitly or explicitly a condition of the individuals contract, player time or volunteerism activity;

2. Submission to or rejection of the conduct is used as the basis for an employment/contract decision affecting the harassed employee; or

3. The harassment has the purpose or effect of unreasonably interfering with the coaches, players, parents, contractors, and volunteers work performance or creating an environment which is intimidating, hostile or offensive to the coach, player, parents, contractor, or volunteer.

Each parent, player, contractor, coach, and volunteer must exercise his or her good judgment to avoid engaging in conduct that may be perceived by others as harassment. Forms of harassment include, but are not limited to:

1. Verbal: repeated sexual innuendoes, racial or sexual epithets, derogatory slurs, off-color jokes, propositions, threats or suggestive or insulting sounds;

2. Visual/Non-verbal: derogatory posters, cartoons or drawings, suggestive objects or pictures; graphic commentaries; leering; or obscene gestures; sending or exchanging explicit emails;

3. Physical: unwanted physical contact including touching, interference with an individuals performance of duties and functions or assault; and

4. Other: making or threatening reprisals as a result of a negative response to harassment.

Any parent, player, contractor, coach, or volunteer who believes that he/she is or may be subjected to objectionable conduct must report it immediately to the Chula Vista Rangers Soccer Club Board of Directors. Do not allow an inappropriate situation to continue by not reporting it, regardless of who is creating that situation. No person associated with or representing the club is exempt from this policy. In response to every complaint, the club will take prompt actions where necessary. Any person who brings such a complaint to the attention of the club in good faith will not be adversely affected as a result of reporting the harassment.

Any person representing or associated with the club, including, but not limited to coaches, contractors, players, parents, volunteers, officers of the club, who engage in objectionable conduct are subject to disciplinary action, including, but not limited to immediate termination of any contracts, player/parents rights, and association with the club.

I hereby acknowledge receipt of this policy and agree to abide by its contents. I understand that failure to adhere to this policy can be grounds for immediate termination of contracts, player/parents rights, and association with the Chula Vista Rangers Soccer Club.

Registration Payment Method

The preferred and most convenient method is our online payments system. This allows for an automated reconciliation of funds and provides our members with the ability to track their payments online. We also accept cash or checks for payment.

It is your responsibility to pay on time. We are doing our best to continue to offer the best program in the south bay at the same cost or less than previous years. Therefore if your account is late, your child (children) may become ineligible to participate in practices and games.

A \$25 fee will be added to your account for each non-sufficient fund check, and a \$25 late fee will be added for payments that are 10 days late.

In the event there is a discrepancy with your payment history, you will need to provide proof of payment. It is important to receive a receipt with your payment, especially cash transactions. Your cleared check is an acceptable proof of payment. Retain all receipts until the 2011-2012 season ends.

Refund Policy

In the event your child decides she/he does not want to play for the Chula Vista Rangers Soccer Club, the following refund policy will apply:

On or before August the 1st. 2011, the refund will be the amount paid towards Registration less:

- \$125 administrative fee
- \$100 uniform
- \$75 dollars per month of training.

Refunds will not be provided after August 1, 2011. Exceptions to the refund policy will be reviewed on a case by case basis.

Player Card:

You will receive a player card when your registration is paid in full or your account is current with an applicable payment plan in place. Your account must continue to be in good standing for the duration of the agreed to payment plan. Otherwise the card will be withdrawn at the discretion of the club thereby making the player ineligible for all practices and games.

If a player decides to leave the Chula Vista Rangers Soccer Club, the player's name, balance due, and payment related information will be reported to Cal-South.

In signing this agreement, I understand and promise to pay all fees in full in order for my child to play with his/her team. If my account is delinquent, I understand my child will not be allowed to practice or play with the team until the account is paid to current or paid in full.

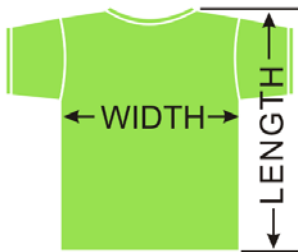
